

## FACTORS FOR DETERMINING INELIGIBILITY TO PROJECT HOMEKEY

The following factors will be used to determine ineligibility for Project Homekey.

If a proposed resident household meets one or more of these criteria, they may be placed in **Pathway 3 – Not Eligible At This Time**. Proposed residents and their advocates may request review and reconsideration of Pathway 3 at any time, and especially if/when their circumstances have changed.

### **Factor 1**

Potential resident household does not meet the criteria for homelessness or at-risk of homelessness per 24 CFR 578.3 regulations

### **Factor 2**

One or more members of the potential resident household is not eligible for participation in a HUD-funded rental assistance program for one or more of the following reasons:

A member of the family:

- ✓ Is a registered sex offender;
- ✓ Has been convicted of manufacturing methamphetamine in an assisted unit;
- ✓ Has a recent history of violent criminal behavior which may have threatened the health and safety of another individual (recent history is defined as more than three documented incidents in the previous 12 month period). This criteria will be evaluated on a case by case basis and completion of an anger management course or other such process may be considered; or
- ✓ Has been convicted of arson.

### **Factor 3**

Potential resident household was removed from the Project Roomkey program as a result of inability to follow the Behavior Expectations of that program and/or proposed resident household caused considerable damage to a Project Roomkey motel room.

*This criteria may be evaluated on a case-by-case basis, and extenuating circumstances may be taken into consideration.*
