

Safety Instructions During a Fire Alarm

Stay calm.

Activate the fire alarm if you smell smoke.

Feel the door before opening - Is it hot? If yes, do not open and seek another exit.

Close the door behind you to help isolate the fire.

Exit the building at the nearest exit and remaining at least 50 feet from the building, do not block exits.

Help your neighbors who are unable to exit the building on their own if it does not put you at risk.

Drop to the ground and crawl for the exit if the area fills with smoke.

Stop, drop and roll if your clothes catch fire.

Gather on the sidewalk across from the west side of the building.

Call 911 when you are in a safe area outside.

Fire extinguishers should only be used if:

- The fire is small and contained.
- You have the means to escape.
- You know how to operate a fire extinguisher.

Staying cool, calm and collected in the event of any emergency is the safest way to respond.
